2023 Survey of Graduating Students

INTRODUCTION:

The 2023 Survey of Graduating Students gathers information on students' satisfaction with their educational experiences. NNMC adopted the survey when it joined the Council of University Presidents (CUP) in 2012.

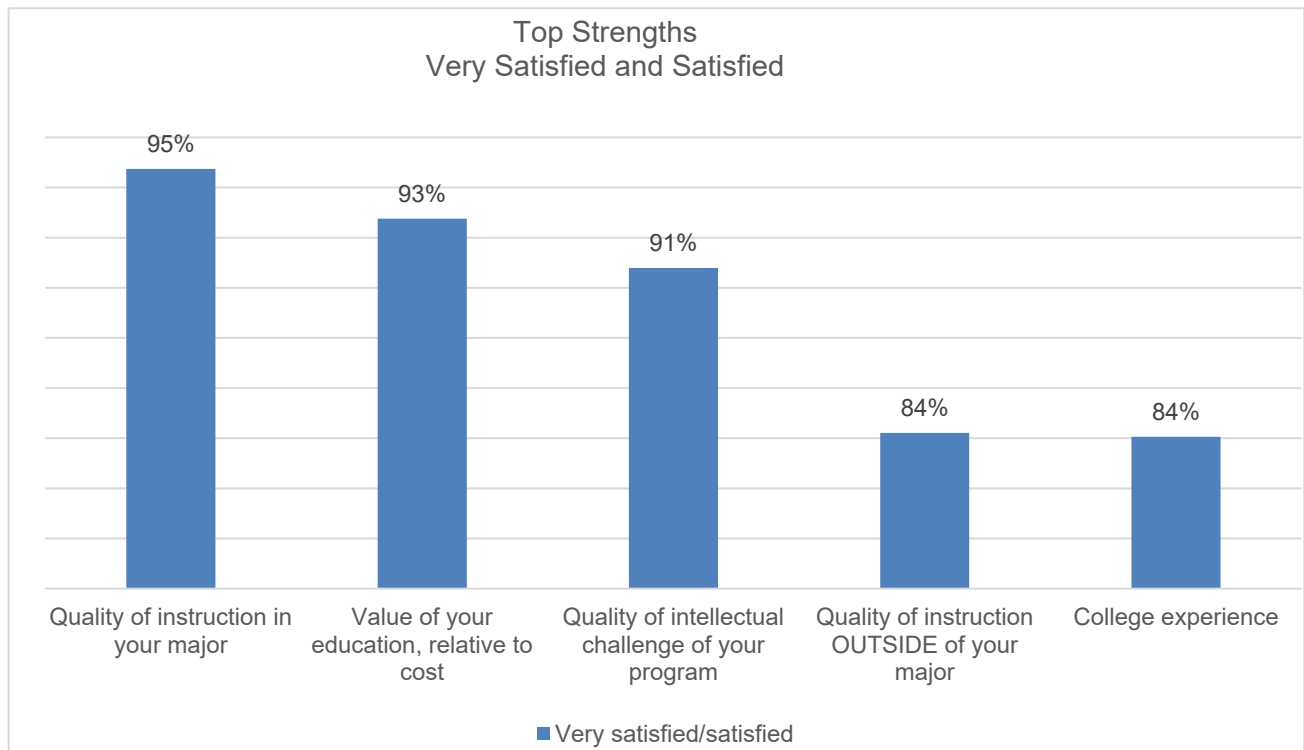
This survey was administered via SurveyMonkey to all graduating students. A total of 222 students received the survey by email between May 1, 2023, and May 17, 2023. Seventy-six students responded, giving a 34% response rate.

The results are as follows:

Students provided responses regarding their satisfaction with various services provided by Northern. Very Satisfied and Satisfied options were grouped as Strengths and Dissatisfied and Very Dissatisfied were grouped as Areas for Improvement.

Strengths:

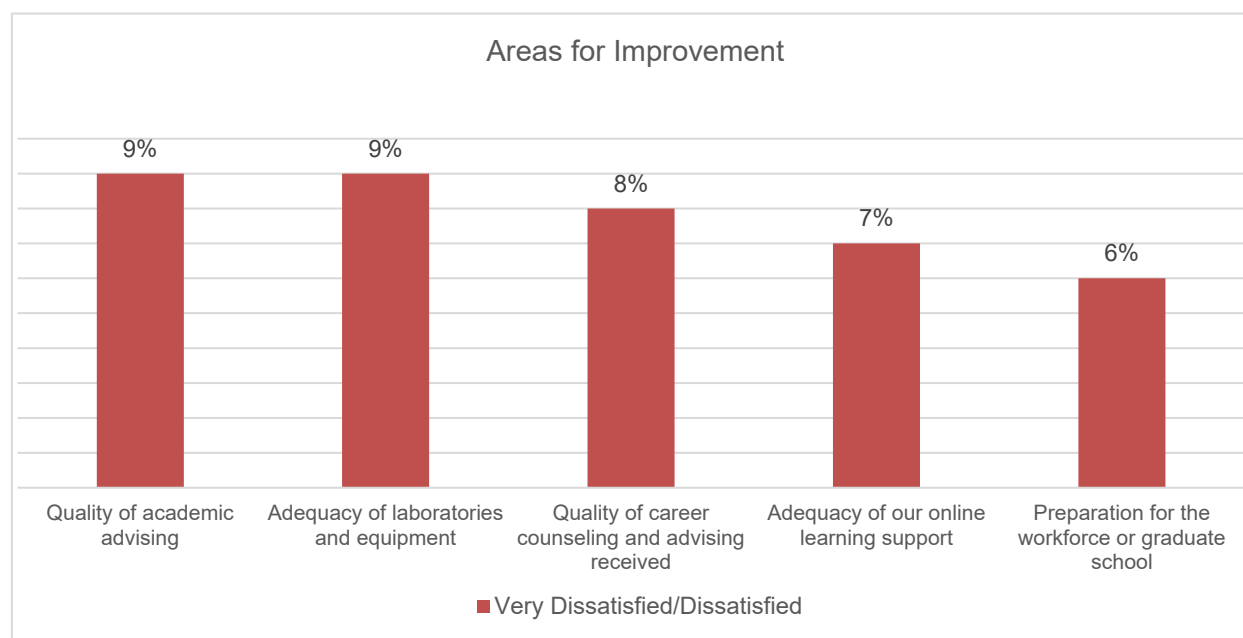
Graduates who completed the survey identified the top strengths as: The quality of instruction in your major (95%), Value of your education, relative to cost (93%), Quality of intellectual challenge of your program (91%), Quality of instruction OUTSIDE of your major (84%), and College experience (84%).



Areas of Improvement:

Graduates who completed the survey identified the top opportunities for improvement as: The quality of academic advising (9%), Adequacy of laboratories and equipment (9%), Quality of career counseling and advising received (8%), Adequacy of our online learning support (7%), and Preparation for the workforce or graduate school (6%).

STUDENT INFORMATION

Program Area of Study

Fifty-seven (57) students responded to the question asked for the Award they received. Forty-two percent (42%) indicated they received a bachelor's degree, thirty percent (30%) an associate's degree, and twenty-five (25%) a certificate (including Alternative Licensure), and three percent (3%) unspecified.

Out of these 57 students who responded to this question, twenty-one percent (21%) were from Business Administration department, twenty-five percent (25%) were from Teacher Education, nine percent (9%) were from Biology, Chemistry and ES, Eighteen percent (18%) were from Arts & Human Sciences, five percent (5%) were from Nursing and HS, nine percent (9%) were from Engineering and Tech, three percent were (3%) from Language and Letters, and eleven percent (11%) were unspecified.

Attend to Northern New Mexico College again?

Out of fifty-seven responded to this question, eighty-nine percent (89%) responded that they would attend NNMC again, and eleven percent (11%) responded that they would not attend.

Choose the same major.

Out of these 57 students, seventy-nine (79%) would choose the same major, and the rest would choose different majors.

What is next?

Graduate School: Out of 18 who would like to go the graduate school, twenty-eight (28%) indicated they would go to Northern New Mexico College, twenty-two percent (22%) indicated the University of New Mexico, eleven percent (11%) indicated Northern New Mexico for BA, and rest to other universities.

Seek Job: The top three places where graduates look for a job were: Los Alamos National Lab (13%), Chama Schools (7%), and Espanola Public Schools (7%)

Already have a job in the same field: Twenty-two students selected this option. The top two places where students have a job already were: Los Alamos National Lab (36%) and Working at Schools (27%).

Teacher (K-12): 12 students selected they would look for a job as Teacher (K-12) around NNMC.

Another field: Two students responded that they would look for a job in another field different than that they graduated from.

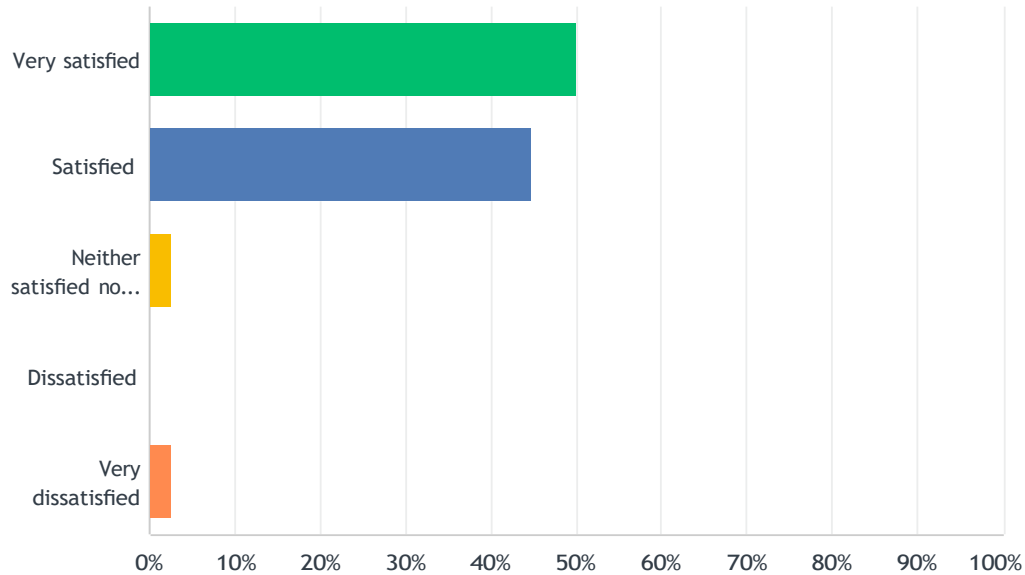
Stay in New Mexico after graduation?

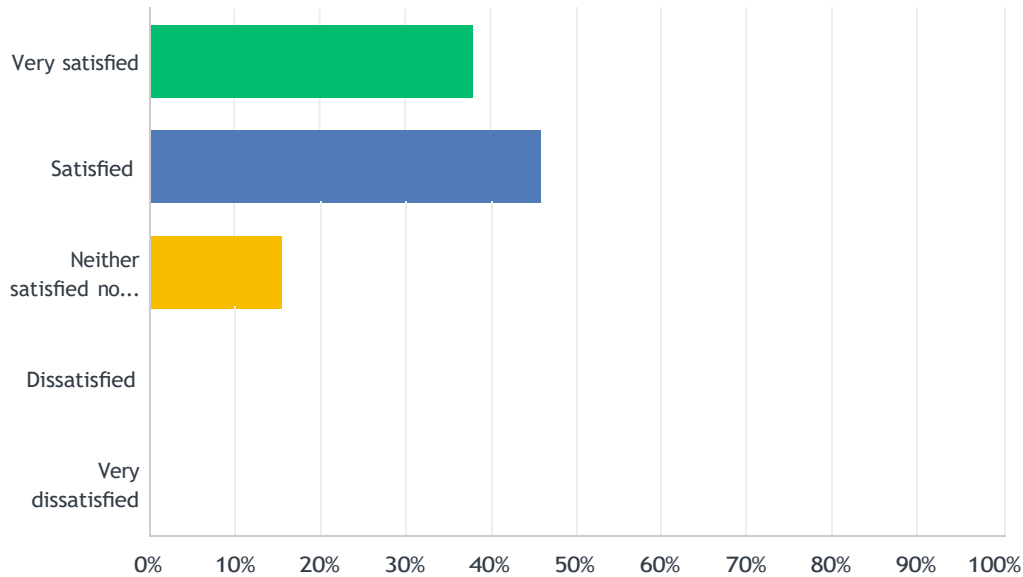

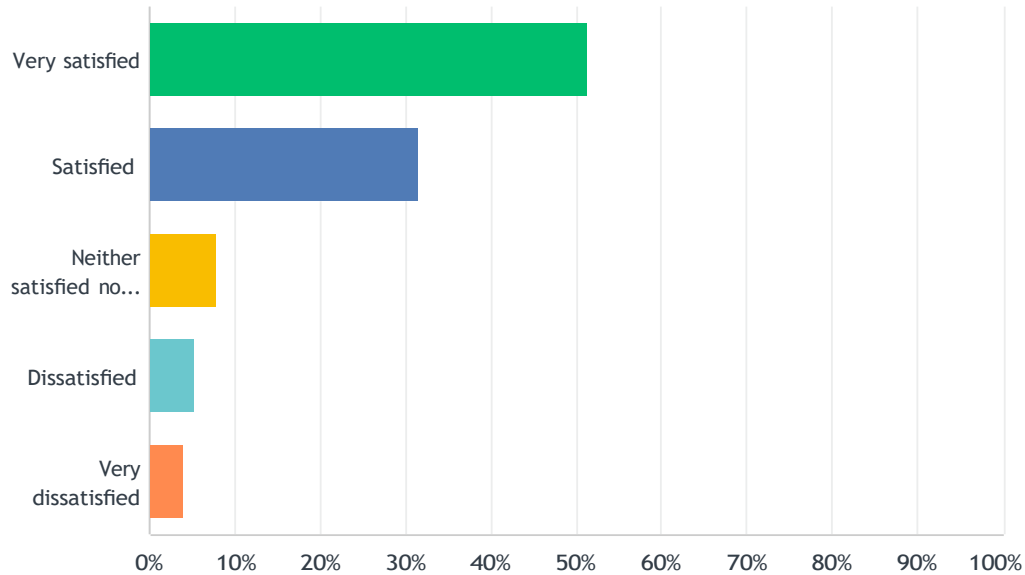

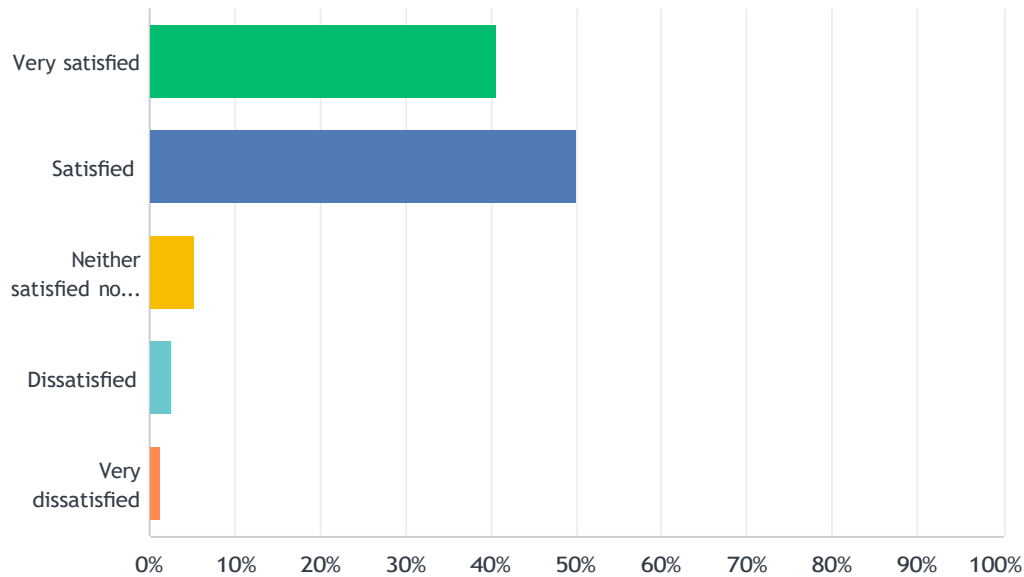

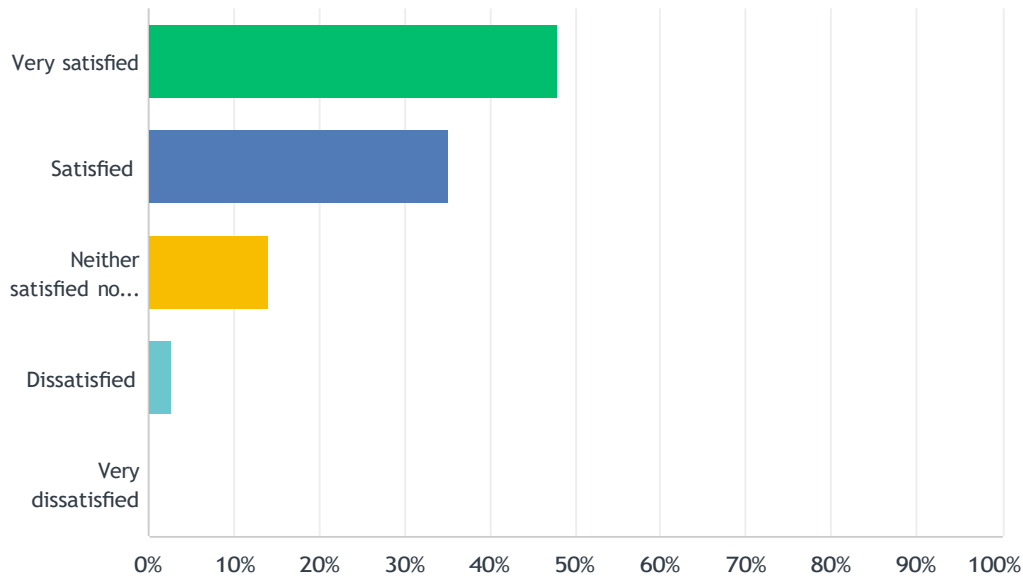

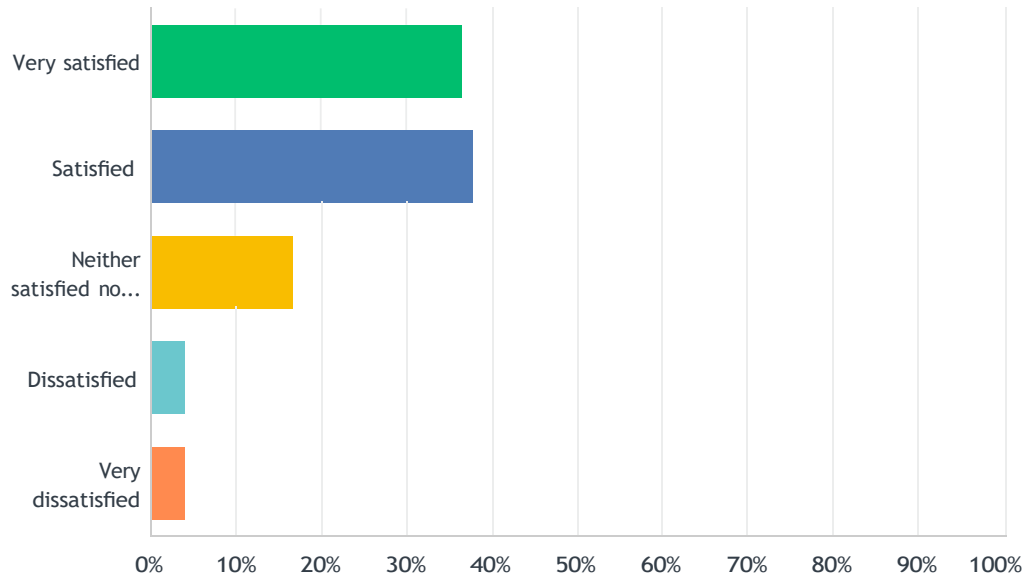

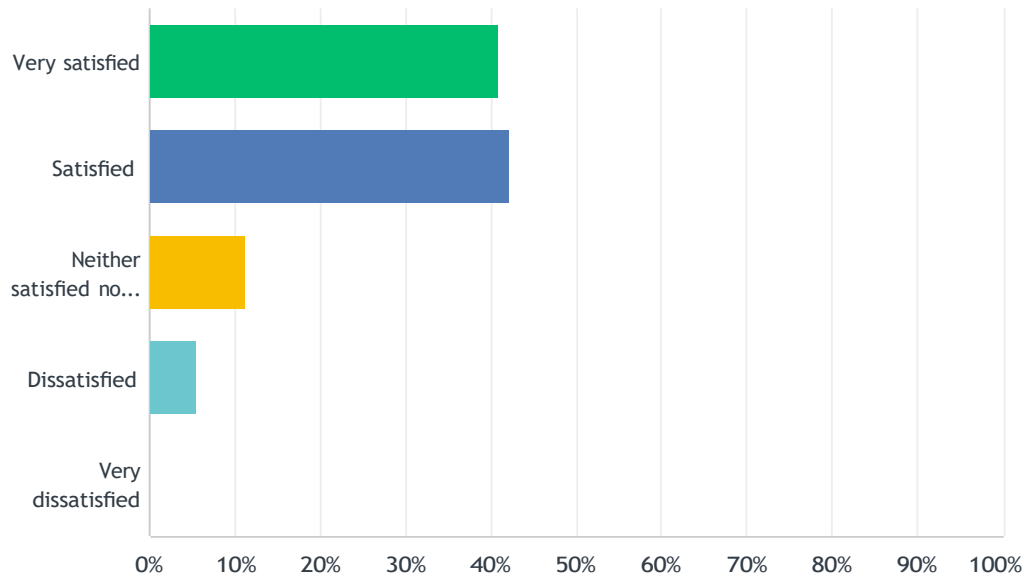

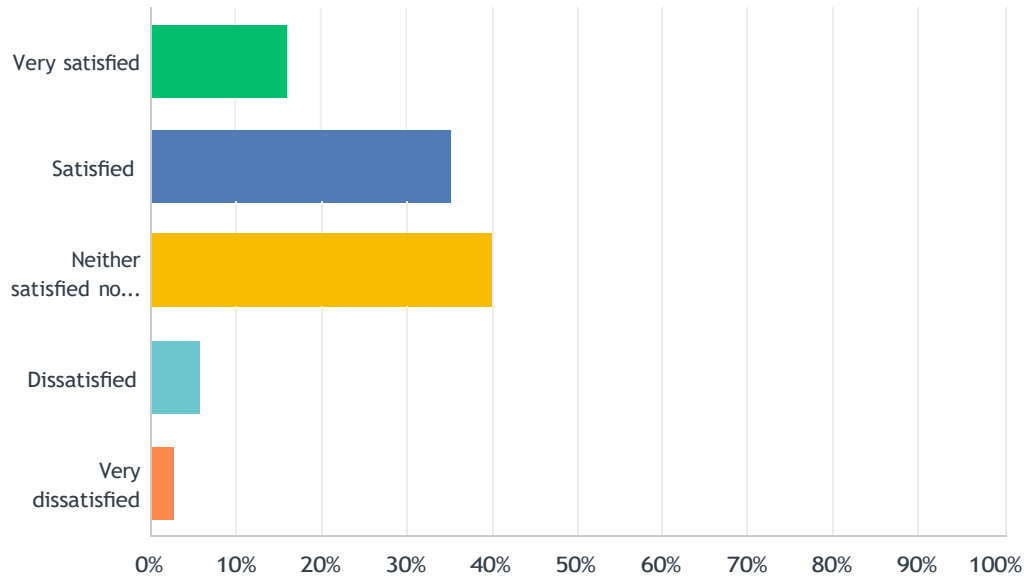

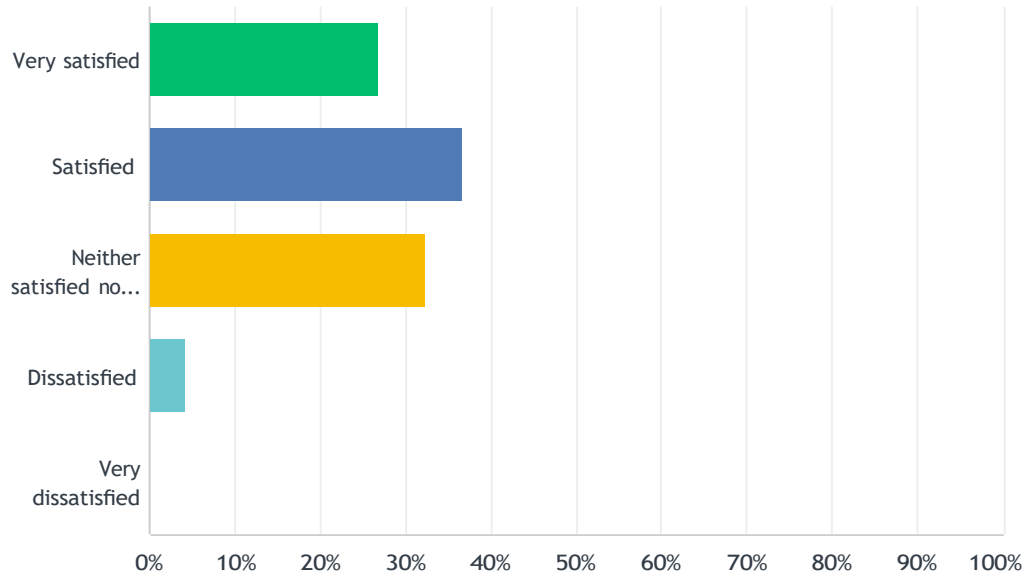

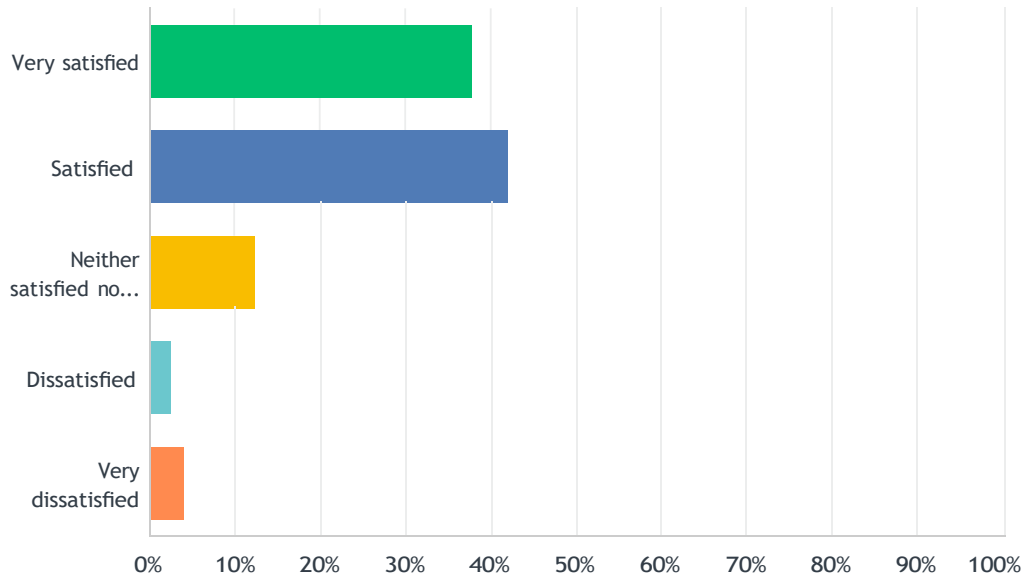

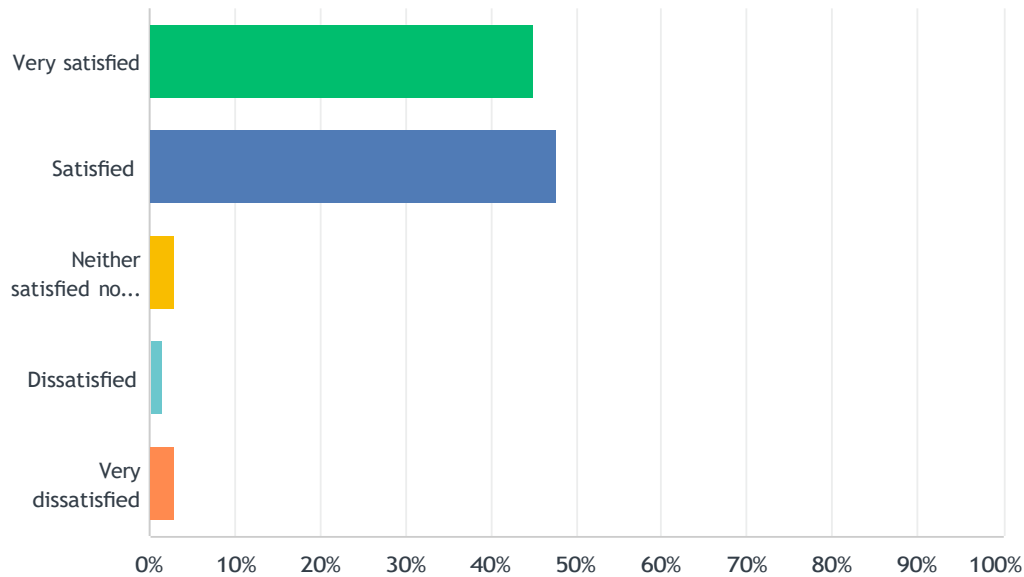

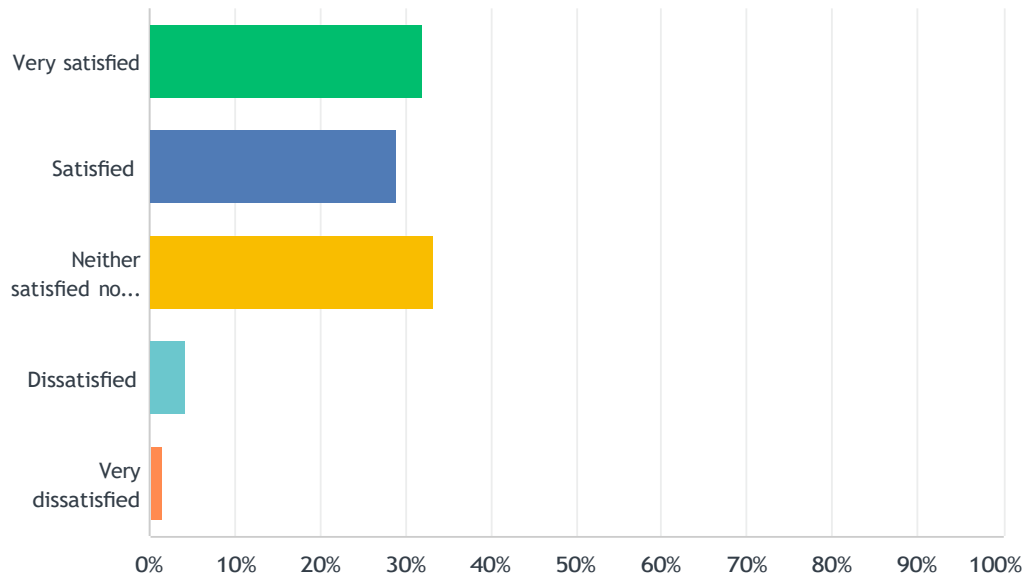

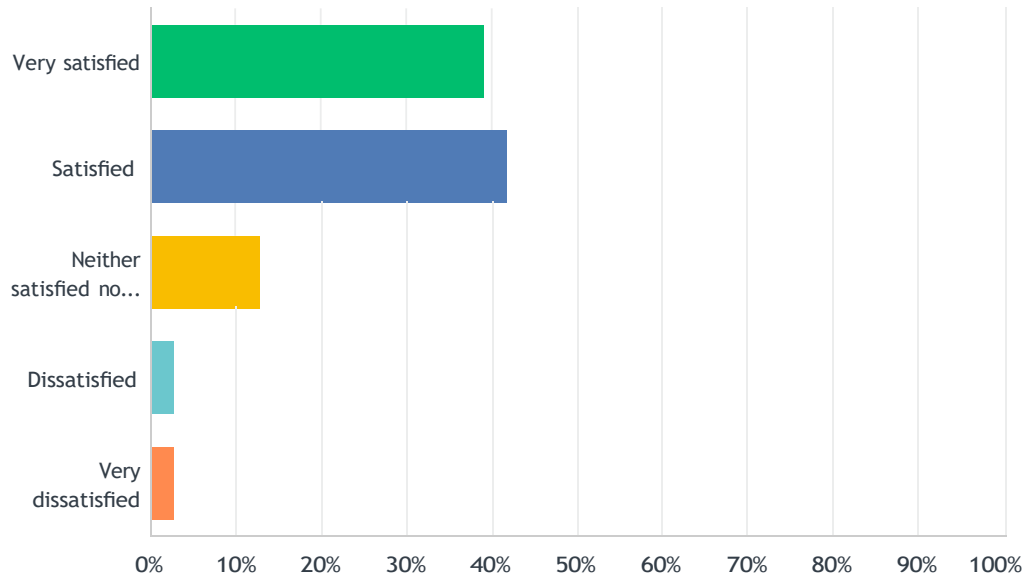

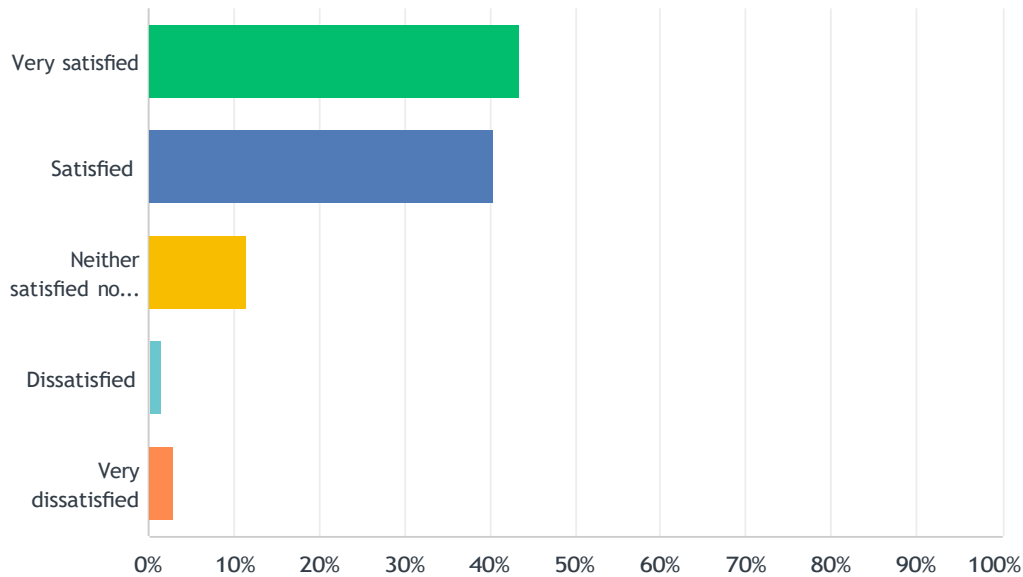

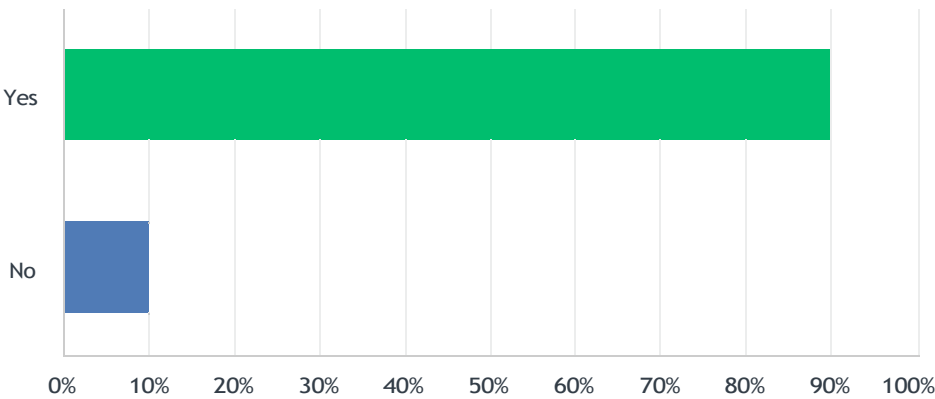

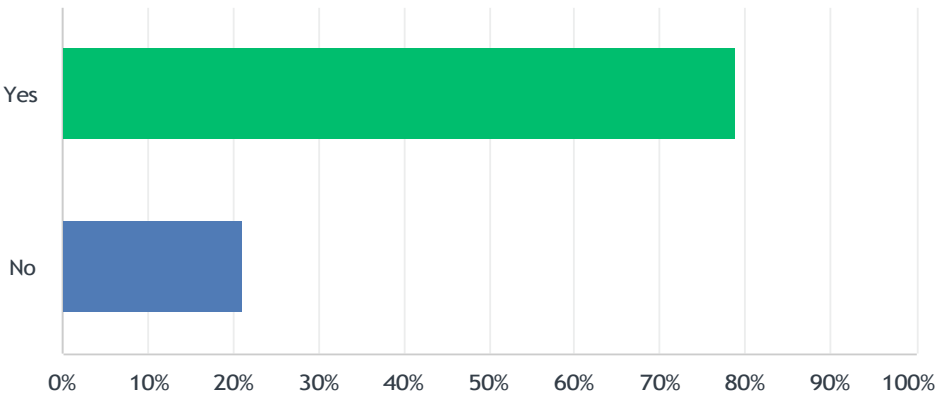
